

### **Instructions for Caption Company.**


1. Schedule a session in your 1CapApp Dashboard. When scheduling be sure "Type" is "hidden."

2. After scheduling and still in the 1CapApp Dashboard click "Hover On."





### **Instructions for Caption Company.**

3. Place cursor on the 1CapApp session you scheduled. Your Session ID will pop on. Give this 1CapApp Session ID to the A/V team, caption company or person responsible for scheduling WebCaptions.






### **Instructions for Captioner.**

4. Captioner will connect to 1Connect and their CAT software and caption as usual. Captioner confirm you are on the

latest 1Connect V1.9,5.

Pay attention to the hardstop the caption company has set on their 1CapApp account. This is the time you can sit idle and not hit your keys before 1CapApp will stop/end the session.






- 1. Register for an account at <a href="https://www.webcaptions.com">www.webcaptions.com</a>.
- 2. Type in your username and password. WRITE IT DOWN. Click login.





3. After you register and login you are taken to the **Events** dashboard. Click on the plus (+) sign to create a new event.






4. Create your YouTube or FaceBook session and copy/paste the link. Fill out all other fields with the appropriate information. Note: Password protect is optional. You do not need to create a password. Time must be filled in

with four place markers, i.e., 08:00 for 8 a.m.


IMPORTANT: Schedule and purchase extra time in case the event goes longer than expected. WebCaptions WILL STOP/END your event if your event runs over the time you purchased. You cannot edit/change this amount after the fact so plan ahead.

Click **Continue**.





5. After clicking the **Checkout** button, you will be taken to your event dashboard.






6. Click on the checkmark and the Session ID box will pop open. Enter the Session ID given to you

by your caption company.

Click Confirm.






7. Click on the pencil to edit your event. You can edit all the settings **EXCEPT** the time you purchased.

You also have a status button. The status button will read planned, pending or active. You can always review

vital information regarding your event by clicking the status button. If you want to start your event early click Start.

Click the **SHARE** button to watch Live session with captions.





### **Instructions for Persons Viewing Captions.**

1. Get the link from the A/V team, caption company, or person scheduling the live event. Viewer options are located below the live video stream which allows a viewer to pick all their favorites: font, colors, position and size of caption box, et. cetera. Viewers can also increase or decrease the font with a simple click.

The next four screen shots were taken of Live YouTube and Live Facebook sessions.

Notice the caption position can be moved to the bottom or the top, middle, left justified . . .


All with a simple click of the mouse.
