



Stream Live Video with Closed Captioning to YouTube, Facebook & Many Other Destinations!

Use 1CapApp and Videolinq to add closed captioning to live streams.

How to Add Captions to Live Streams?

With **1CapApp** and the **Videolinq** Platform, adding closed captioning to live streams is a simple 5-step process:

1. Open a **Videolinq.com** account and login to the media dashboard. Create a Channel, Destinations, and a video Source. Find under the channel preview player the closed captioning credentials. Copy the stream key and password. See tutorial video: <https://videolinq.com/video-tutorials>.
2. Open an **1CapApp.com** account. Under "My Company" find the Videolinq box and enter the "password" in the form of "aaaaaaa@bbbbbbb:ccccccc" (see image 1 below). Next, go back to the home page and click on the "Quickstart" icon. Drop down the "Videolinq" option and type in the channel "stream key" in a form of "ddddddd:bbbbbbb" (see image 2 below).
3. Start the video source. Confirm you see video in the **Videolinq** preview player.
4. Send captions data to the **1CapApp** service. Confirm you see closed captioning in the **Videolinq** preview player. Click "Go Live" and enable all the destinations of the channel.
5. Video with closed captioning will display on supported platforms and services. Viewers will be able to enable/disable closed captioning on their player.

IMPORTANT: Not all social media platforms & streaming video service providers support closed captioning.


Step 2: QuickStart “Export Platform – Videolinq”. Type here the Videolinq channel stream key.
